**Re: 2012/19 Directive of Waste Electrical & Electronic Equipment (WEEE)
2011/65 Directive on Restriction of Use of Certain Hazardous Substances (RoHS)**

Guy-Raymond do not manufacture electrical or electronic equipment and, therefore Directive 2012/19 does not apply directly to any of the products supplied by us.

*We can confirm that all components manufactured and materials used by us do comply with the 2011/65 RoHS directive including exemptions in schedule III as listed below:

Exemptions:

6a (not more than 0.35% Lead in steel)

6c (not more than 4% Lead in brass)

**We are aware of the current ECHA review of the RoHS list and we are aware of the extensions applied to the exemptions 6(a) and 6(b) until July 2021. We will be monitoring closely to ensure that Guy Raymond Engineering is compliant with appropriate legislation.*
